

On Time — Install on Your Phone

Add it to your home screen so it opens full-screen, like a real app.

FIRST — IT HAS TO LIVE AT A WEB ADDRESS

“Installing” a web app means opening its link on the phone, then adding it to your home screen. On Time lives at mapjamaica.org/map-dose-tracker.html. Open that link on the phone, then add it to your home screen — the steps below.

Step 1 — Confirm it opens

On the phone, open <https://mapjamaica.org/map-dose-tracker.html> and check it loads.

Step 2A — On iPhone (use Safari)

1. Open the link in **Safari** (not Chrome — only Safari can add to the home screen on iPhone).
2. Tap the **Share** button — the square with an up-arrow, at the bottom center.
3. Scroll down and tap **Add to Home Screen**.
4. It shows the name **On Time** — tap **Add** (top right).
5. An “On Time” icon appears on your home screen. Tapping it opens full-screen.

Step 2B — On Android (use Chrome)

1. Open the link in **Chrome**.
2. Tap the  menu (top right).
3. Tap **Add to Home screen** (or **Install app** if offered).
4. Confirm the name **On Time** → **Add**.
5. The icon lands on your home screen.

Step 3 — Use it

Tap the icon → **Setup** → enter your medication + first dose → **Start my day**. Because it's hosted (not the Claude preview), your entries now **save and persist on that device** between opens — as designed.

Note: on iPhone the icon may show a small screenshot rather than a custom logo — a single HTML file has no app-icon image. It works perfectly; it's only cosmetic. A proper gold “OT” icon is a quick add if you want one.
